

## **Protection concept for the Museum Langmatt 2021**

The protection concept is based on Federal recommendations and those of the canton of Aargau and VMS (Verband der Museen der Schweiz, the Associations of Swiss Museums).

### **Park**

- Masks must be worn on the entire area of the Museum Langmatt

### **Disinfection**

- Please disinfect your hands as you enter
- No-contact disinfection stations are located at the main entrance and outside the Veranda Café
- Disinfectant dispensers are located in all WCs
- Strategic locations and surfaces are disinfected several times a day

### **Museum**

- A maximum of 50 people are allowed in the museum, in the exhibition *Raumfahrt V* max. 13 people
- Masks are compulsory in the museum (protective masks available at the cash desk) The regulation applies to visitors aged 12 and over
- Tours and workshops are limited to a maximum of 15 people. Distance 1.5 meters
- Indoor events are limited to a maximum for a maximum of 30 people and outdoors of 100 people (each seated). Distance 1.5 meters
- Unannounced groups of max 10 persons only with contact details of the organizer
- Maximum permitted number of visitors:
- Plexiglas barriers at the reception
- Cash-free payment at the cash desk possible/desired
- Activities for children are disinfected and quarantined after use
- Audio guides to the exhibition and offers in the park work contactless via app on your own device
- All seats 1.5 metres apart
- Gloves are available for looking at catalogues and are washed after use
- The cinema stays closed

### **Cloakroom / Shop**

- Transferred from entrance to the Venetian Room
- Cash-free payment possible/desired

### **WCs**

- Please clean your hands thoroughly as recommended by the BAG
- Paper towels and disinfectant are available

### **Veranda Café (self-service) / Terrace**

- No seating in the Veranda Café
- All consuming guests on the terrace must register with the QR code **(Logging in and out)**
- Guests are requested to stay in the Veranda Café only as long as necessary and to consume outside after they have served themselves
- Disposable tableware and cutlery, serviettes packed individually
- Doors in the Veranda Café are open when possible
- Cash-free payment with Twint possible/desired
- Contact-free refuse bins
